


Orangutan Population

Fires are being set to clear land for palm oil plantations, which are destroying orangutan habitats.

Many orangutans are dying when they are unable to escape the fires.

There are **fewer than 60,000 orangutans left in the wild** in their native Borneo and Sumatra.

Unfortunately, orangutans live in areas that are favored for establishing oil palm plantations: fertile lowland soils close to rivers.

Orangutans have lost their food sources to the palm oil plantations and are considered pests. They are being killed when they venture into the plantations searching for food.
